

The monthly meeting for the Town of Grant was held August 8<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

Chairman Mark Dietsche called the meeting to order. Minutes of the July 11<sup>th</sup>, 2022, meeting were read. Supervisor David Buchner a motion to accept the minutes as read. Supervisor Brad Larson seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The treasurer's report was given. Motion made by Dave Buchner to accept the treasurer's report, seconded by Brad Larson. Motion carried.

Supervisor Dave Buchner asked for public comment.

The WTA meeting was fairly quiet. Drug testing was discussed, and the county has decided to no longer provide drug testing. Mark Dietsche has volunteered to look into this.

BIL funding is no longer available. Cedar Corp. representative, Dennis Macke, came to the meeting and further explained LRIP-S and LRIP-D. These are two very different funding programs than the traditional LRIP. The town will further discuss having an engineering firm apply for this funding. There is current interest in applying for this funding. LRIP-D is discretionary funding and is 50/50. LRIP-S is Supplemental funding and will pay up to 90/10.

Patrolman's report was given. Current town paving plan is to finish 930<sup>th</sup> Street and pulverize part of 1170<sup>th</sup> Ave next year. Also looking at working on 810<sup>th</sup> Street, and there is an additional road through the bluff west of Cty Rd W that is getting rough. Fire Extinguishers for the town shop need to be recharged or replaced.

Motion to approve lot location for Aaron Sonnenberg by Mark Dietsche and seconded by Dave Buchner. Motion Passed.

Bills were audited, approved, and paid.

Brad Larson made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Dave Buchner. Motion carried.
