Patrolman's report was given. The county came and looked at the cattle pass/bridge on 756<sup>th</sup> street. The concrete supports are showing some cracking. The patrolmen went through today and filled all holes and cracks with cold mix. They will keep a close eye on this area. There may be a weight limit applied to this guard to prevent accidental injury.

Dave will look into getting new tires on the plow truck. The damaged culvert on 930<sup>th</sup> street has been replaced and the town is looking into burying the culvert a little deeper to prevent further damage and heaving.
